The buildings

The property, which is surrounded by parkland trees consists of:

- a traditional Bastide (Aixoise Maison de Maitre / main house)
 (580m²) 8 bedrooms, 5 bathrooms
- a beautifully restored 19th century stone farmhouse (360m²) with large dining room, cinema, games room, kitchen, guest bathroom, studio apartment for guests or staff
- a pool house (120m²)
- an orangerie (100m²)
- a pigeonnier (pigeon loft) (120m²) with potential for three further bedroom / bathroom suites with a private garden
- a guardian house (approx. 130m² renovation permit approved)
- an agricultural hangar (120m²) for tractors, etc.
- a spacious garage complex for four cars with plenty of storage space for bicycles and motorcycles.

- A new tennis court with a dynamic world-class compacted artificial grass surface
- A 17-metre heated swimming pool

- Wrought iron gates through olive estate to main house

Behind beautiful wrought iron and stone gates is an estate of 25 acres of rolling views to the mountains in the South, olive groves and lavender, cypress trees, mature oaks and fruit orchards. Here you and your family can relax in your own personal haven of peace. Away from the tourists and hustle and bustle of the teeming Cote d'Azur, this estate is bathed in the sunshine, tranquillity and richness that is Aixen-Provence and the Luberon.

This estate is one the rarest of properties in Provence. Set in the heart of its own parkland gardens, with a beautiful main house and extensive outbuildings, the property benefits from plenty of light and space. With incredible views over the rich French countryside to the mountains of the Massif de l'Etoile in the far south, this estate and its buildings blends tradition and modernity on the doorstep of cultural Aix-en-Provence, one of the most vibrant, beautiful and entertaining cities in France.

For the Golf enthusiasts, the property is perfectly situated, across the road from the 18-hole golf course of the nearby Set Club which offers spectacular views, tennis and paddle courts, gym, beauty treatments and a full range of restaurants and services.





About the property

The main house is a 19th Century Aixoise Maison de Maître (Gentleman's House), accompanied by a beautifully restored farm house constructed of local stone, and a range of additional outbuildings and garage spaces.

It is evident that the position of the property was selected with great care, to optimise the views while at the same time maintaining complete privacy. Nestled under the hills to the North and West, the house is perfectly protected from the occasional Mistral winds, while benefitting from sunshine throughout the day from the uninterrupted views to the South of the Property.

Around 1,000 olive trees are planted all around the estate. Every year, these trees are harvested and yield a steadily increasing volume of exceptionally high quality oil, linking the estate to the traditions and activities of the local area, now famous for the production of some of the best olive oil in Europe. And over 40 mature indigenous trees form a magnificent avenue leading directly to the front of the main house.









Bedroom 2




































Around the area

La Provence

La Camargue

The Camargue is a triangular area situated on the coast between Languedoc-Roussillon and Provence. It is a river delta where the Rhône meets the mediterranean – a marshy island bounded by two branches of the Rhône and the sea. An 'island' of 85,000 hectares boasting herds of wild white horses, flamingos and other rare birds and flora and fauna, spread out amongst the wetlands and salt marshes of this huge Natural Park which is only an hour away from the estate.

Pays d'Aix en Provence

The famous spa town of Aix-en-Provence, often referred to as the city of a thousand fountains, is famed for its long history, classical architecture, wide tree line Boulevards and, of course, unsurpassed street markets. On the doorstep of the estate, just 10 minutes by car to the centre, you will find a huge range of shops and daily food markets in the city's most beautiful squares.
